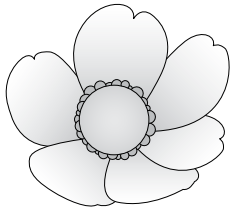


January Materials List

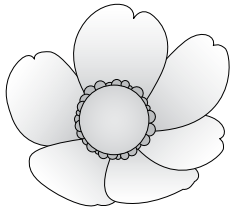
