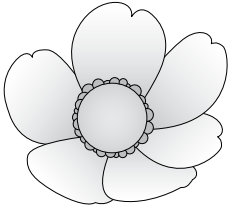


# November Materials List

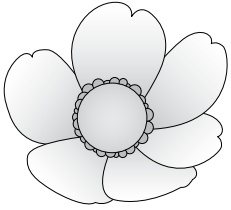
