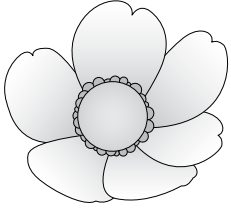


September Materials List

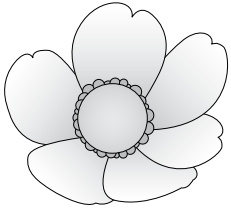
