

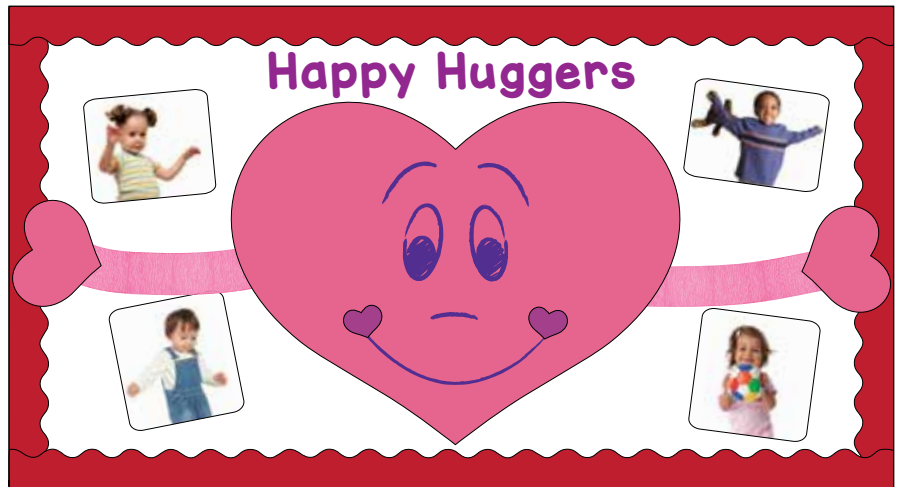
Build a Print-Rich Environment with Bulletin Boards!

Ages 0-3

Happy Huggers

Cover the bulletin board with white paper and add a red border. Cut a large heart shape from pink poster board. Draw a smiling face on the heart with smaller hearts for cheeks. Attach the pink heart in the middle of the board. Fasten a streamer to each side of the heart and pin them to the board like outstretched arms. Cut two smaller hearts and attach them to the ends of the streamers as hands. Display photos of the children around the heart and add the caption "Happy Huggers."



Ages 3-5

Blooming with Kindness

Cover your bulletin board with colorful paper and add a strip of green to the bottom for grass. Attach a colorful border, if desired. Print the title "Blooming with Kindness" at the bottom of the board. Cut flower shapes and stems out of paper and attach them as though they are growing out of the grass. Print photos of each child, and place the photos on the flower blooms.

Ages 3-5

Eating the Rainbow

Cover your bulletin board with light colored paper and add a decorative border, if desired. Cut pictures of fruits and vegetables from grocery ads or magazines. Or, print clip art from the Internet. Invite children to help you arrange the foods into a rainbow shape, sorting by color. Attach the foods to the bulletin board in the same shape to create a colorful rainbow. Add the title "Eating the Rainbow."
