Activities

Family Trip

Observation Skills

To develop observation skills, look around your house with your child for different colored items. How many red objects can you find in each room? How many green items can you find outdoors? Continue to further enhance observation skills by searching for shapes. How many circle items can you find? How many square items? Ask your child to name a shape and then search together to find items of that shape.

In a large bowl, mix together enough of the ingredients so that you have about one cup of trail mix for each person in your family. Place a plastic scoop or cup in the bowl. Invite your child to place a scoop of trail mix into a small plastic zipper bag for each family member.
