Recipe

Ladybug Gelatin Treats

4 envelopes unflavored gelatin 4 cups cranberry juice cocktail chocolate syrup

Measure juice into a saucepan.

Sprinkle gelatin over the juice. Let stand for one minute. Place over low heat and stir until the gelatin is dissolved. Pour into a 9" x 13" pan. Place in the refrigerator until firm. Use a round cookie cutter to cut circles. Dab on chocolate syrup to make spots. Enjoy!
