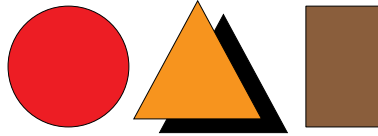
Summer Days

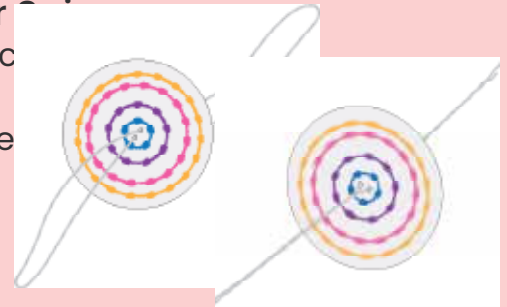
Active Outside
