
Build a Print-Rich Environment with Bulletin Boards!

Ages 0-3

Look Who's Hanging Out!

Cover your bulletin board in light blue paper and add a red border. At the top of the board, use red letters for the caption "Look Who's Hanging Out!" Below the caption, create a clothesline with yarn. Cut out simple clothing shapes such as pants or shirts. Label each with a child's name. You may also add a photo if you'd like. Use clothespins to clip the cutouts to the line, if desired.





Ages 3-5

Mirror, **Mirror**

Cover your bulletin board with light-colored paper and add a decorative border, if desired. Print photographs of the children to attach to the board. Add the title "Mirror, Mirror, on the Wall" to the top of the board. Add the title "Who's in Preschool This Fall?" to the bottom of the board. Cut two handheld mirror shapes from paper and attach a mirror board or foil circle to the center of each paper mirror. Attach the mirrors where you wish.

Ages 3-5

Fastening Up for Fall

Cover your bulletin board with colorful paper and add a seasonal border, if desired. Print the title "Fastening Up for Fall." Take photographs of the children fastening different types of clothing and shoes. For example, you might show a child buttoning his shirt or attempting to tie his shoes. Print the photographs and attach them to the board.
